

State Cake Recipe

<u>Ingredients from the canteen or Bi-Annual Food Boxes</u>

4 honeybuns

6 oatmeal cream pies

2 Hershey's chocolate bars

1 individual packet of M&M's

Tools and Materials

1 flat piece of cardboard that is being thrown away

1 plastic bowl

1 spork

1 trash bag

Access to a microwave

Step 1: Prepare your Ingredients

- Using a garbage bag to cover your cooking area, open all of your oatmeal cream pies. Using your spork, scrape the cream out of them into your plastic bowl.
- o Break up your chocolate bars and add them to the bowl with the cream

Step 2: Form Your Cake

- Place your honeybuns on the cardboard base. This will be the foundation of your cake. 4 honeybuns placed together to form a rectangle is just fine, but feel free to get creative with the shapes!
- Take the oatmeal cookie halves and shape them onto the honeybuns. This will take some squishing and forming. You might want to have found plastic gloves for this process.

Step 3: Ice Your Cake

- When it is your turn, microwave your bowl with the cream and chocolate for 2minutes. Pause the microwave every 30seconds in order to stir the icing with your spork.
- Drizzle the icing over the cake.
- While the icing is still warm, sprinkle M&M's into the melted icing.

Step 4: Gather and Enjoy

- Gather a few of your closest friends wherever gathering happens to be permitted at that time, grab the birthday girl, and enjoy!
